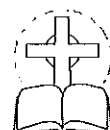

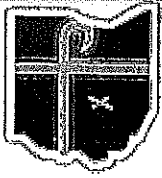
But God isn't just any father. Watson offers these reasons why God is "the best Father".

From the Regional Moderator

To all Ohio Clergy,

Since Friday, March 24th, we have begun to live with the reality of the sudden retirement of Dr. Bill Edwards as Regional Pastor and President in Ohio. While this may be a challenging time in the life of our regional church it is where we find ourselves.

As we sort through the many things that are necessary during any time of transition, we entreat your prayers for our regional staff and for the mission of the Christian Church in Ohio. We are also inviting your participation in that mission, to help us discern the next steps of what God is calling us to do and be as we seek *"to act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with [our] God"* (Micah. 6:8). Finally, we are realizing that what is most needed at this time is that we listen to each other, speak the truth in love, act with grace and mercy, and to practice our discipleship through an intentional period of spiritual discernment and to recommit ourselves to the high calling of Christ upon our lives and our church!

To that end Rev. Steve Bentley, our Acting Regional Minister, and I will be visiting clergy groups around the state to listen, share, think and pray as Disciples of Christ are called to do. If you have a planned gathering of clergy and/or laity, please let us know so that one or both of us can join you in that

time of intentional fellowship. If you do not have a scheduled gathering but would like to do so, simply be in touch and we'll do everything possible to coordinate with you. Of course you are free to call or email us at anytime.

Finally and quite candidly, we are experiencing a time of great fiscal uncertainty. We have many pressing expenses and yet, want to sustain the ministries to which God has called us as a region. To that end, I am asking each congregation as well as individual donors to consider a sacrificial gift to the Leadership Fund of the Christian Church in Ohio. This fund specifically supports the Regional Ministries and as the generosity of God's people is yet again revealed, we will also be working to right the ship through other fiscal decisions that will provide a bridge to a brighter, stronger and even more faithful church might bear witness to the love of God in Christ!

Make this heartwarming handprint gift to give your dad or another special man on Father's Day.

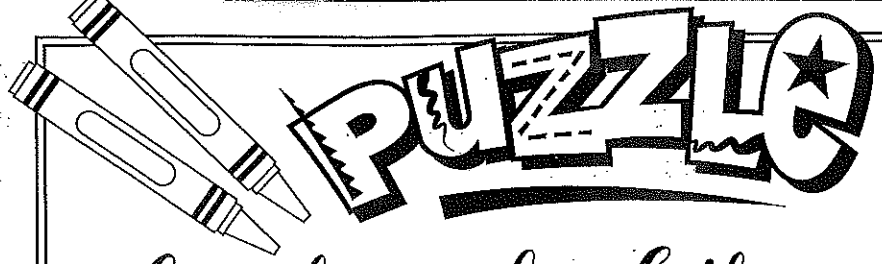
What you need:

What you do:

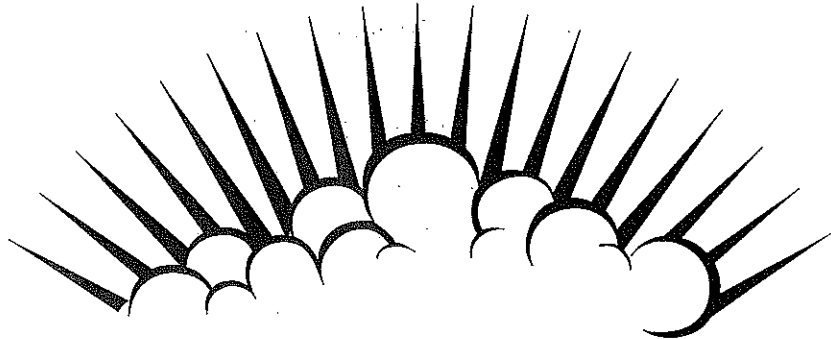
1. Place paint on the paper plate.

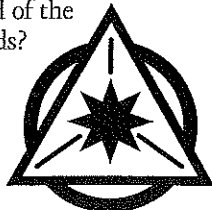
